Ernte prize 2014 (translated)

Claire Ochsner

In 2014 the canton of Baselland bought 2 artworks for the regional art collection.

In recent years, the artist has perfected her skill in creating sculptures and has long made use of the technical possibilities offered by the automobile industry. While Ochsner's early work relied more heavily on naturalistic forms—resulting in crocodiles or oversized "fantastic" animal figures—she has in recent years developed a playful style of colorful, rounded, and often moving forms. Claire Ochsner's oeuvre shapes the public spaces of the canton like no other.

Claire Ochsner (*1948), grew up in Zurich, lives and works in Frenkendorf. The artist was a member of the Art Commission Basel-Landschaft and is now represented for the first time in the Kunstkredit Baselland collection with the acquisition of two works.
